GOVERNOR / LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

DAVID L. WILLIAMS / RICHIE FARMER (R) - ENDORSED →

Steven Beshear / Jerry Abramson (D) - no response, pro-abortion positions, Gov. Beshear supports his Party Platform position on abortion (see below). As Mayor of Louisville, Jerry Abramson approved \$1.2 million in publicly funded contracts with Planned Parenthood, the nation's leading abortion provider.

ATTORNEY GENERAL

TODD P'POOL (R) - ENDORSED →

Jack Conway (D) - **MUST BE DEFEATED**, no response to KRLA PAC survey or National Right to Life PAC survey; strong pro-abortion position, said on "Straight Talk" (August 24, 2001) with John Yarmuth that his position on abortion is like Bill Clinton's. The Rothenburg Report (March 8, 2002) said "Conway aligns himself with the Clinton approach to abortion." (Bill Clinton vetoed the ban on partial birth abortion twice and issued five pro-abortion executive orders immediately after taking office.) Speaking to students at Manual High School, Louisville (February 22, 2002) Conway said he was "pro-choice" and added "All right, if you got up and shaved your face this morning, sit down and shut up, cause this is not your issue. That's the way I feel about it."
