Kentucky's largest pro-life membership organization calls for a thorough investigation.

Louisville . . . Today the Kentucky Right to Life Association, the state's largest and oldest pro-life organization, has called for an investigation of **Planned Parenthood of Kentucky and Indiana** after an undercover video surfaced showing a senior-level Planned Parenthood of America medical director, Dr. Deborah Nucatola, describing how to perform late-term abortions in ways to maximize profits from the sale of intact fetal body parts.

"Governor Beshear and Attorney General Jack Conway should immediately investigate Planned Parenthood of Kentucky and Indiana to find out if its affiliates are participating in illegal abortions that seek to maximize profit by the most barbaric and unjust means – the sale of aborted baby body parts. Dr. Nucatola is Planned Parenthood's medical director, and if she is directing affiliates, she is clearly describing what sounds to me like partial birth abortion, which is illegal." said Margie Montgomery, executive director of Kentucky Right to Life.

A group called The Center for Medical Progress used actors with a hidden camera, who posed as buyers from a human biologics company to capture video and remarks of Dr. Deborah Nucatola, senior director for medical services for the Planned Parenthood Federation of America (PPFA). In the video, Dr. Deborah Nucatola is heard discussing how to perform abortions to remove the fetus as intact as possible in order to sell tissue or parts for medical research.

"I don't know what's more inhumane, Dr. Gosnell talking about aborting babies big enough to walk him to the bus stop, or watching this callous woman sipping wine as she quips 'we've been very good at getting heart, lung, liver, because we know that, so I'm not gonna crush that part. I'm gonna basically crush below, I'm gonna crush above, and I'm gonna see if I can get it all intact'." continued Montgomery.

Kentucky Right to Life is the State's only affiliate of the National Right to Life Committee and is the pro-life advocate for legal protection of unborn human lives and their mothers in the Kentucky legislature.
