Indiana Right to Life Executive Director Keynotes Milestone Celebration of State's Oldest and Largest Right to Life Chapter

Louisville, Ky. – Right to Life of Louisville, Inc., founded in 1970, will be celebrating its 50th anniversary as Kentucky's premier grassroots, citizen organization defending the unborn, elderly, and medically vulnerable, 7:00 p.m. (6:00 p.m. Social Hour), Thursday, July 16th, at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, 830 Phillips Lane, Louisville, Kentucky.

Keynoting the annual "Celebration of Life Banquet" will be Mike Fichter, president and CEO of Indiana Right to Life, who will address the recent incursion of America's deadliest purveyor of abortion into the Bluegrass.
